Statistics

946 applications were submitted (4 not eligible)

149 doctoral networks will be funded (success rate 15,8%):

- 123 Standard DNs
- 14 Industrial DNs
- 12 Joint DNs

Total budget €429.4 million to train over 1650 doctoral candidates
