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Medical model of disability

Medical model of disability (traditional)

Most common for majority of the countries

Claims that people are disabled by their impairments and should be 'fixed' or treated even when the impairment or difference does not cause pain or serious illness Developed as modern medicine surfaced and advanced during the 19th century

Disability is a deficiency or abnormality

Being disabled is negative and problematic

No equal rights

Disability is only an individual issue



- Individual education plan






Social model of disability

- Developed in the UNITED KINGDOM during the Civil Rights Movement by Michael Oliver and colleagues
 - Developed initially by Union of the Physically Impaired Against Segregation (UPIAS) in 1970s
 - Disability is a difference. Contrast to medical model.
 - Defines 'disability' as social oppression rather than form of impairment.
 - Disability does not represent a person, but part of his/her life.
 - Disability-related problems can be solved by societal changes/inputs/collaboration.
- Equal rights to all life aspects.





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


