

# Call for application: Course on Translational Research and Medicine Development



The ENLIGHT-TEN summer school<sup>1</sup> consists of an introductory e-learning (~10 hours student investment time) followed by a 5-day face-to-face workshop. The course is intended for PhD students in the second half of their PhD and early postdocs who are involved in biomedical research.
