Agenda Topic:	Implementation of the Action Plan of MCAA-BG_Chapter
Discussion:	 An overview of activities implemented in line with the Action plan of the Bulgaria-Chapter was presented by Anife Ahmedova, Chair of the Chapter, and was followed by short discussion on future activities: Organization of a happening in the South park of Sofia – The participants welcomed the idea; mid–July was identified as suitable time for the event Invitation was extended to all Chapter members for participation in the MSCA Conference in Bucharest, the 2019 event of the Romanian Presidency of the Council of the European Union. Several members emphasized on the importance of participation in all MSCA conferences. Gabriella Tchouprenska suggested allocation of money in the Chapter budget for participation in the next MSCA conferences.
