Two BIG Tips

Less is MORE

PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT



Audience

- Researchers
- Policy makers
- Practitioners



Less content

- Reduce or skip literature review/background
- Cover one research question
- Limit and simplify charts and tables
- Estimate one minute per slide



Get Attention

- Ask a question
- Provocative fact or visual
- Have audience "do" something



Keep Attention

- Eye contact
- Smile
- Hands
- Movement



How to Practice

- Practice at least 3-4 times...
- In office before you leave
- In hotel
- In actual presentation room
- Videotape



More Tips

- Bring your materials
- Avoid Power points notes
- Try new ideas
