

The location of Venice





The city of Venice



Venice stretches across 120 small islands in the Venetian Lagoon along the Adriatic Sea, in Northeast Italy. Historically known as *La Serenissima Repubblica* (i.e. the 'most serene' republic), it has an extraordinary historical heritage thanks to its role as cultural and commercial crossroads of Europe for a thousand years.

Venice is also a modern town. It is the main city of the Veneto Region, in Northeast Italy, and has a total population of about 270,000 inhabitants: about 60,000 in the historic centre; 180,000 in the mainland, mostly in Mestre and Marghera; 30,000 in the other islands of the lagoon.





Ca' Foscari Palace

The main seat of the University is Ca' Foscari Palace, the Venetian-Gothic building located on the largest bend of the Grand Canal. The palace was purchased and renewed by Doge Francesco Foscari in 1452.

It contains important artistic and architectural works, such as a room with a 16th century stucco work by the Venetian sculptor Alessandro Vittoria (1525-1608) and a great hall designed by the Venetian architect Carlo Scarpa (1906-1978), with two murals by Mario Sironi and Mario de Luigi.

Between 2004 and 2006 Ca' Foscari underwent a painstaking restoration programme, which was awarded the prestigious "Torta Prize" in 2007. It is possible to visit the palace with the Ca' Foscari Tour Service (www.unive.it/tour).





Ca' Foscari University of Venice



Established on August 6th 1868 as a Royal Business College, Ca' Foscari University of Venice was the first educational institution in Italy to offer higher education in business and economics.

Nowadays, Ca' Foscari offers 4 main subject areas (Economics, Humanities, Languages and Sciences).



Ca' Foscari actively participates in the city cultural life, organizing over 400 events every year, collaborating with other prestigious cultural institutions and organizing successful art exhibitions at "Ca' Foscari Esposizioni", the exhibition space in the main building.






ERC main funding schemes complementarities

STRATEGIES: Career development: what we do 1

How does the research office help young researchers?

- 1. Communication campaigns:
 - website
 - social networks
 - newsletters and targeted emails
 - info-days
 - Researchers' night and public engagement activities
- 2. Guidance in order to match the researcher's competencies and proposal with the most approriate financial instrument
- 3. Creation of the "Expression of Interests" form as a tool to allow researchers to interact directly with the Research Office
- 4. Mapping and communicating individual funding opportunities



STRATEGIES: Career development: what we do 2

- 5. Practical guidance to project design (specific lessons also!)
- 6. Annotated guide for applicants and application forms
- 7. Proposals' reviews by experts and NCP
- 8. Support during the grant preparation phase
- 9. Management of funded projects.



Overcoming barriers to entry

Writing an application should not be a "loss of time"...

- We value above-threshold projects in post doc recruiting
- We support the **resubmission**





Creating (new) opportunities

- Growing number of PhD scholarships and post doc research grants, with a focus on interdisciplinarity
- Permanent positions open to excellent researchers employed as permanent faculty members by a foreign universities or research institute



Dealing with ...



- We support and encourage applications to ERC Grants
- We hire ERC grantees from abroad We offer:
- Tenure track position (starting grant)
- Associate professor position (consolidator)

- We foster our MC Fellows career development: an additional year funded by Ca' Foscari ...
- to allow researchers to exploit their research results in a better way...
- and apply for an ERC Grant choosing Ca' Foscari as host institution!
